- 1. The prize will be awarded to a Ph.D. thesis defended during the year 2018.
- 2. The *deadline* for application is May 31, 2019.
- 3. Applicants must submit their Ph.D. theses according to the instructions that can be found at the address:

The selection committee of the prize consists of three members, which are nominated by the AGTA Council; the Committee selects the winner, and can additionally mention a second deserving candidate. Moreover, the Committee may decide not to award the prize, in case of absence of adequate scientific applications.
